

Strada Vecchia **2018 BARDI**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1 TEAMS AND VEHICLES

- 1.1 Each team must have a minimum of 2 members.
- 1.2 Once a vehicle is registered with at least 2 team members named, additional team members may be added at a later date. Full details of team members must be submitted to the organisers by 30/4/18.
- 1.3 Whilst there is no limit to the number of additional team members, teams should restrict themselves to that legally permitted within the vehicle.
- 1.4 Drivers must be over the age of 18 and have a full UK driver's licence. There is no age restriction for non-driving passengers.
- 1.5 One member in each team must be designated as Team Leader. The Team Leader will be the main contact for the organisers and is responsible for coordinating his team and sharing information provided by the organisers.
- 1.6 A list of contact details for both the organisers and other teams will be provided and the team leader is responsible for notifying the organisers in writing of any changes to their team or their details.
- 1.7 A classic vehicle is defined as being 25 years or over on 1st June 2018. Non classic vehicles are welcome to participate in all elements of the event with the exception of the display in Bardi. Only classic vehicles will be allocated a space in the Exhibition/Display area.
- 1.8 Exhibition Display spaces in Bardi will be allocated at the discretion of the organisers.
- 1.9 Participants are responsible for insuring their vehicles and must carry all required documents with them at all times.
- 1.10 The organisers do not provide breakdown or recovery service for vehicles and teams are strongly advised to purchase breakdown support.
- 1.11 The Strada Vecchia event is limited to 20 places and all teams must be registered before 30/4/18 after which participation cannot be guaranteed and entry will be at the discretion of the organisers.
- 1.12 Teams have the option to take part in a series of fun challenges during the journey to Bardi. These are easy and exciting to do and there is a prize for the team with the highest score. Details will be sent with the Info Pack.
- 1.13 Each team will be provided with four Strada Vecchia Team Plates. One to be displayed in the front windscreen, one in the rear window, one to be carried and displayed clearly in the marker photographs and challenge photos and one for spare. Plates must be displayed in the vehicle at all times.

2 TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

- 2.1 Teams are responsible for booking their ferry in advance of the event.
- 2.2 Teams are required to take a team photo on the ferry. (See route details in the Info Pack).
- 2.3 The accommodation at the hotels in Sainte-Croix, Lago Maggiore and Bardi is based on 2 people sharing. If this is unsuitable for any members of your team, the type and number of rooms required may be entered on the Registration Form. We will make every effort to accommodate your requests.
- 2.4 Details of allocated accommodation in Bardi will be provided nearer to the date of the event. As there is limited accommodation available within Bardi itself, the accommodation will be as proximate to the town as possible.
- 2.5 Shuttle transport will be provided on Thursday and Friday to and from the accommodations and Strada Vecchia planned events. The shuttle is not available to participants who have opted out of the Bardi accommodation package. Shuttle details and timetables will be finalised nearer the event.

3 ROUTE

- 3.1 Teams are required to make a photo record of their journey at a number of designated marker locations. There are 12 marker locations to ensure that teams follow the assigned Strada Vecchia route. Teams must stop and take a team photograph at each of these marker locations, with the Team Plate visible as a secondary means of authentication.
- 3.2 The Strada Vecchia route has been carefully planned. To qualify for the Certificate of Achievement you must obtain a photograph at each of the designated markers. If, for reasons beyond the control of the organisers or participants, a marker location is unavailable to all teams, this marker will be eliminated from the overall event and will not affect qualification for the Certificate of Achievement. More details are given in the Route document in the Info Pack.
- 3.3 Teams are welcome to deviate from the route as long as the required marker points are reached and verified by means of a photo.
- 3.4 The organisers reserve the right to amend the Strada Vecchia route if such amendment is deemed essential for the event. Organisers will use reasonable endeavours to communicate any changes to the participants at the earliest opportunity.
- 3.5 There will be a designated assembly point just before the final destination, Bardi, where facilities will be made available for vehicles to be cleaned and prepared. Teams are required to arrive here by 14:00 to enable them to participate in a group convoy into Bardi.

4 OTHER ACTIVITIES

- 4.1 Each team member will be allocated 1 ticket for the Gala Dinner. Tickets are non transferable. Subject to numbers, additional tickets may be made available nearer the time. If you are interested in purchasing additional tickets, please tick the relevant box on the Registration Form. We will try to accommodate all requests but additional tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

5 GENERAL

- 5.1 Unless otherwise stated within the inclusions, all costs of participation are the responsibility of the teams.
- 5.2 The event will be photographed and recorded. Unless otherwise notified on the Registration Form, the organisers reserve the right to use and publish images and recordings for the purposes of promoting and celebrating this or future Strada Vecchia events.
- 5.3 A commemorative album will be created from the event and will be distributed after the event. 2 albums will be provided per team and additional albums can be also be purchased.
- 5.4 The organisers are not responsible or liable for delays arising from industrial action, weather and travel conditions and the actions of third parties. Should any unforeseen events occur, teams must use their judgement and make alternative arrangements to rejoin the event as soon as possible.

6 PAYMENTS AND CANCELLATIONS

- 6.1 The first payment (calculated at time of registration) will be required within 14 days of registration, giving participants an opportunity to check travel arrangements and confirm their commitment to participate.
- 6.2 Upon registration a receipted invoice will be sent to the team leader along with confirmation of additional payments and their due dates.
- 6.3 An invoice will be issued in advance of payment due dates.
- 6.4 An invoice will be raised for extra team members added for the sums due at the date of their addition.
- 6.5 The team leader as team coordinator will be invoiced and responsible for all sums due in accordance with the payment schedule outlined above
- 6.6 If the event is cancelled by the organisers, all monies paid to the organisers under the terms of this agreement will be refunded.
- 6.7 In the event of payments not being made, the organisers reserve the right to terminate this agreement upon written notice. All sums due at the date of termination under the terms of this agreement will remain payable and the organisers do not accept any liability for any costs incurred by the participant direct or indirect arising as a consequence.

7 DISCLAIMER

The organisers will publish event information and details of vehicles participating on a number of media. We endeavour to ensure that all information is accurate at time of publication. Should any errors occur, these will be rectified, where reasonable and practical to do so, upon notification.

8 RESERVED RIGHTS

The organisers reserve the right to amend or modify elements of the event where necessary, due to circumstances beyond their control. This includes, but is not limited to, route or marker changes due to road closures, accidents or diversions. In such circumstances the organisers will use reasonable endeavours to notify participants of such changes.

9 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- 9.1 The organisers accept no liability for injury to participants or loss or damage to vehicles or property during the Strada Vecchia event. Participants are advised to have appropriate insurance cover and keep property and valuables with them at all times.
- 9.2 The organisers cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs incurred by participants arising as a result of weather, industrial action, road and traffic conditions and any other events outside their control.

10 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 10.1 Teams are encouraged to dress according to the year/style of their vehicle. A prize will be given for the most authentically dressed team.
- 10.2 Prizes will be given for the following categories:
 - Best presented classic vehicle
 - Best 4pm Tea Stop photograph
 - Best dressed team according to vehicle age/style
 - Highest Challenges score
 - Certificate of Achievement for vehicles submitting all the marker locations photographs
- 10.3 An Info Pack containing all the information and documents needed for the Strada Vecchia event will be sent out with the registration deposit invoice.
- 10.4 The Info Pack also contains a schedule of key dates and times along with a checklist guide to the essentials for your trip.
- 10.5 Participants are requested to adhere to all journey times set out in the Information Pack where practical and possible to ensure the smooth operation of the event and full participation by the team.
